We have prayer booklets for classes where prayers to be learned or recognised are recorded for class use.

School Prayers

These are to be taught to the children during class reflection times and will be used throughout the school day.

In Reception Class, the morning prayer is sung. It is:

Good Morning Lord, We praise your holy name, We thank you for giving us, A lovely new day, Amen.

In Class 1 and 2, the morning prayer is:

Dear God,
Help me to do the things I should,
To be kind to others and good,
In all I do at work and play,
To grow more loving every day,
Amen.

In Key Stage 2, the morning prayer is:

I am promising , dear Jesus to follow you today ,
To obey your every word, in all I do and say,
To always be a loving child,
Helpful, kind and sweet,
To give the love you give to me to everyone I meet,
But if this promise I shall break and if I bring you sorrow,
Then help me to begin again and keep my promise tomorrow,
Amen.

At Lunchtime all children across the school say the lunchtime prayer in class. Some classes choose to sing this prayer.

Bless us oh Lord as we sit together
Bless the food we eat today, bless the hands that made the food,
Bless us O God
Amen.

In Reception Class, the end of the day prayer is:

Dear Jesus, Thank you for our day at school, Please look after us and our families, And keep us safe, Amen.

In Class 1 and 2, the end of the day prayer is:

Thank you God for my nice day, For fun and friends at work and play, Thank you for your loving care, At home, at school and everywhere, Amen.

In Key Stage Two, the end of the day prayer is:

Oh my Lord,
I come to say,
Thank you for your love today,
Thank you for my family,
And all the friends that you give to me,
Guide me through the dark of night,
And in the morning, send your light,
Amen.

In Our Gospel Assembly, our Golden Book Assembly and in our Key Stage Liturgies, we say the Our Father and the Hail Mary and we say a prayer for the sick. We also sing the Alleluia in our Gospel Assembly.

Our prayer for the sick:

We pray for all our family and friends who are sick,

That they may feel God's love.
