MFL (French) Teacher Job Description

Job Role

- To have responsibility for teaching French to Year 5 and 6 within the school week.
- To be jointly responsible for the day-to-day work and management of teaching MFL (French) and the safety and welfare of the pupils taught.
- To promote the ethos of the school through the teaching of French.

Main Duties & Responsibilities

- To create and manage a caring, supportive, purposeful and stimulating environment which is conducive to children's learning.
- To plan and prepare lessons in line with the school's MFL scheme and the National Curriculum.
- To identify clear teaching objectives and learning outcomes, with appropriate challenge and high expectations.
- To maintain good order and discipline among the pupils, safeguarding their health and safety.
- To consider and adapt for the needs of individual and groups of pupils in each class.
- To monitor, assess and report on pupils' progress in French, under the direction of the French Subject Leader.
- To ensure effective use of support staff within the classroom.
- To ensure that school policies are reflected in daily practice.
- To liaise with the class teacher and the French Subject Leader on the teaching of French, as necessary.
- To continue professional development, undertaking training as required.
- To promote the welfare of children and to support the school in safeguarding children through relevant policies and procedures.
- To promote the British Values, including equality and to treat everyone with fairness and dignity.
- To recognise health and safety is a responsibility of every employee, to take reasonable care of self and others and to comply with the Schools Health and Safety policy and any school specific procedures / rules that apply to this role.
- To exemplify the vision, aim, values and ethos of the school through professional and personal behaviours.
